<p><u>Autumn 1</u></p> <p>Narrative: Write a caption for a well-known character. Recall a range of nursery rhymes. Retell a nursery rhyme in a 5 part story. Texts - Humpty Dumpty/Little Miss Muffet/Little Boy Blue/Mary had a Little Lamb</p> <p>Non-narrative: Write labels, captions and sentences linked to Nursery Rhymes.</p>	<p><u>Autumn 2</u></p> <p>Narrative: Retell the story of the Little Red Hen. Text - The Little Red Hen by Pie Corbett.</p> <p>Non-Narrative: Factual writing linked to the Little Red Hen; labels and lists. Write messages to the Little Red Hen.</p> <p>Factual writing linked to Christmas celebrations; labels and lists.</p>
<p><u>Spring 1</u></p> <p>Narrative: Write a simple 5 part fairytale. Text: The Rainbow Princess by Pie Corbett</p> <p>Non-Narrative: Factual writing linked to The Rainbow Princess -Lists, labels, write messages to the Fairy.</p> <p>Factual writing linked to Chinese New Year - Happy New Year messages, list animals from the Chinese New Year story.</p>	<p><u>Spring 2</u></p> <p>Narrative: Write a simple innovation of Old Mac's Farm. Text: Old Mac's Farm by Pie Corbett</p> <p>Non-Narrative: Factual writing linked to Old Mac's Farm - animal lists, animal descriptions, diagrams and life.cycles. Write information about chicks.</p>
<p><u>Summer 1</u></p> <p>Narrative: Write an innovation of Sharing a Shell. Text: Sharing a shell by Julia Donaldson.</p> <p>Non-Narrative: Factual writing linked to Sharing a Shell. Write factual sentences about sea creatures. Create a booklet about sea creatures.</p>	<p><u>Summer 2</u></p> <p>Narrative: Write a story with a 'sleepy' character. Texts: The Sleepy Bumblebee by Pie Corbett, Peace at Last by Jill Murphy</p> <p>Non-Narrative: Factual writing linked to The Sleepy Bumblebee - Write factual sentences about minibeasts. Write information about minibeasts.</p>
