Travelling to/from school – Health & Safety

Please be aware you **MUST NOT** park on yellow lines outside the school. Not only is this a health and safety risk to adults and children travelling in and out of the school grounds but this is causing problems for our local residence who are unable to get access to their own vehicles/driveways.

In addition, the school carpark is not an access route into and out of school. On entry into the school grounds please ensure you follow pathways before entering the gate on the big yard. **DO NOT** enter the gate via the car park. This is no longer an access route and due to the volume of cars in the car park it is not safe to use for entry and exit purposes.

Finally, there are a number of bikes and scooters being left at the front of the building, outside the pram store. This is not a storage area for bikes and scooters and is a trip hazard for anyone entering and leaving both our school and Biddick Hall Childrens Centre. If your child rides their bike/scooter to school parents and carers must ensure it is taken home. We are currently trying to secure a safe place to leave bikes/scooters but at present bikes and scooters **MUST NOT** be left on the school premises throughout the school day.
