It has been so lovely to welcome the children back into school this term. All of the children look so smart in their school uniform and have settled back into school life very well.

Please remember the timings of our school day. All pupils in reception, year one and year two are expected to be in class and ready to learn for 9am. Gates are open from 8.45am and will close at 8.55am prompt. Any child that arrives at school after this will have to be signed in via the school office and will receive a late mark. Late arrivals will be challenged and late marks monitored so please ensure your child arrives at school on time.

Gates will open at 3pm at the end of the school day.

All children have been provided with a school reading bag and water bottle. Reading books and water bottles should be brought into school every day.

Finally, children in year 1 and year 2 have two PE lessons each week. On PE days your child should arrive at school wearing their PE uniform. For health and safety reasons earrings must be removed before children come to school to allow them to take part in their PE lesson.
