Year 1 have spent some time outside of school in the local community as part of their learning in Science. They were able to explore local habitats and wildlife and everyone had a fantastic time!






Attendance - Important Information

Please remember the timings of our school day. All pupils in reception, year one and year two are expected to be in class and ready to learn for 9am. Gates are open from 8.45am and will close at 8.55am prompt. Any child that arrives at school after this will have to be signed in via the school office and will receive a late mark. Late arrivals will be challenged and late marks monitored so please ensure your child arrives at school on time.

Gates will open at 3.15pm at the end of the school day.

If your child is unable to attend school for any reason you must notify the school office (0191 9330830) on the first day of absence by 9am. As per our attendance policy, where any pupil we expect to attend school does not attend, or stops attending, without reason, the attendance manager will call the pupil's parent on the morning of the first day of unexplained absence to ascertain the reason. If the school cannot reach any of the pupil's emergency contacts, the school may complete a home visit, contact services who are working with the family or where there are identified concerns contact the police.
