The Theme: Embracing the chilly winter and early spring weather while exploring cold places and communities around the globe.

★ What Your Child is Learning

- **Freezing & Melting (Understanding the World):** Exploring real ice and snow with our senses, and learning about community helpers like doctors and firefighters.
- **Story Adventures (Literacy):** Acting out We're Going on a Bear Hunt using puppets, masks, and handmade telescopes.
- **Counting to 5 (Maths):** Mastering "one-to-one" counting (pointing to each item as we count 1, 2, 3, 4, 5) and comparing sizes.
- **Winter Dressing (Physical Development):** Becoming absolute champions at managing zips, buttons, hats, scarves, and wellies independently.
- **Resilience & Goals (PSED):** Working with a partner and learning to keep trying even when a task feels a little bit tricky.

Play simple instructions games at home (like "Simon Says") to help them practice following two-part directions. Encourage your child to use kind words to cheer others on.
