The Theme: Enjoying the warm sunshine while learning about farm animals, tractors, and where our food comes from.

★ What Your Child is Learning

- **Life on the Farm (Understanding the World):** Discovering where different farm animals live (like pigs in a sty) and matching animal parents to their babies.
- **Farmyard Stories (Literacy):** Reading Farmer Duck and What the Ladybird Heard, and using farm small-world sets to make up our own complex stories.
- **Positional Language (Maths):** Learning how to follow and use position words like in, on, under, besides, and between.
- **Climbing & Traveling (Physical Development):** Building large muscle strength by climbing apparatus using alternate feet, skipping, hopping, and jumping.
- **Speaking in Sentences (CLL):** Building confidence to speak in full sentences of six words or more and expressing our own points of view.
