To assist in this we recommend that each student has access to structured independent revision.

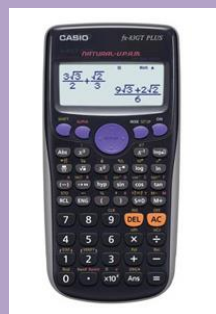
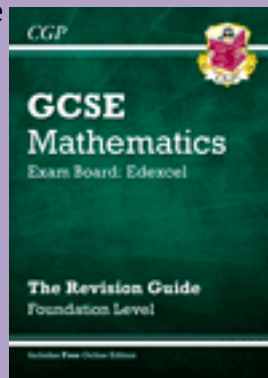
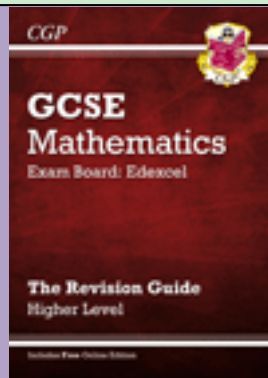
