

## The Great War and Winstanley Community College



As part of the World War One Centenary 2014-2015, Winstanley Community College is setting up a student led focus group to raise awareness of the war and help to develop its legacy for future generations.

Starting in the autumn of 2014, to coincide with the outbreak of war, students from Winstanley will be creating a film investigating the "Lost Generation" of the community which will be part of the schools legacy for the future.

As a school, we will be organising a whole school centenary day and also working with the wider community to create a meaningful remembrance of the war and its effects.

Students will also be working in partnership to raise funds for the Royal British Legion through a student led 14-18 legacy project.
