The governing body is a voluntary group of people who have general responsibility for the conduct of the school with a view to promoting high standards of educational achievement. There are three key roles and responsibilities that governors fulfil, in order to achieve that goal:


- ensuring clarity of vision, ethos and strategic direction. The governing body achieves this by agreeing policies and deciding the priorities for improvement to be included in the school development plan
- holding the head teacher to account for the educational performance of the school and its pupils. Teaching and learning is the primary role of the school, the governing body offer support, constructive advice, a sounding board for ideas, a second opinion on proposals and help where needed
- overseeing the financial performance of the school and making sure its money is well spent. Assessing the impact of spending decisions, ensuring financial efficiency and sound financial practices

Governors are expected to be strategic, act as a critical friend to the school and ensure accountability in all areas, not simply finance.

The responsibilities and powers of governance have to be exercised in partnership with the head teacher and staff.

Winstanley has 12 governors; they will be introduced in the next edition of our newsletter.
