
How will my exam grades be decided this summer?



Your teachers will give exam boards a centre assessed grade that will remain private. This will be based on a number of sources, including; homework, classwork and coursework and the grade will be estimated based on what these sources tell us your grade is likely to have been if you were to have taken exams.




Your teachers will rank students in your year to work out who is most likely to achieve a particular grade. This information will remain private.



The final grade will be decided by the examination board. They will use the evidence provided by your teachers and any previous exams results which may include SATs.

What will happen next?



Your results will be released on **Thursday 20th August 2020**. We will update you on arrangements for collecting results when we have more information.



The results will be treated in the same way as if you have taken the exam. You will use them to progress on to your chosen study route.

Once you have your results you will have **two options**;



Accept

OR

sit exam in
the Autumn
Term



If you are happy with your grades you can **accept** them and if you are unhappy with them you will be given the opportunity to **resit** the exams in the Autumn Term.
