Minimum Intervention

- Student a
 - Student and parental meeting with Head of School/Assistant Head
 - Ongoing liaison with alternative providers
 - Possible alternative curriculum



- Student and parental meeting with Asst Head of School and HOY
- Re-integration programme, Inclusion Programme
- Behaviour report, PSP and regular reviews



- Student and parental meeting with SLT link, HOD, HOY
- PSF
- Daily Behaviour report



In addition to the interventions below:

- Phone call home HOD/HOY
- HOD/HOY student discussion
- Report card (Form, Faculty, HOY, SLT)



- Text message / email home
- Tutor / student discussion
- Information logged on SIMS
- Negative behaviour points

Teacher discretion will be used at these times to decide upon appropriate sanctions. If inappropriate behaviour is ongoing over multiple lessons. Specific sanctions may be agreed following discussions with HOD/HOY.

Assault of student; Smoking/alchohol; vandalism; theft; verbal abuse of staff; discriminatory behaviour bullying; misbehaviour in IB

Prejudiced incident; fighting (not assault); failure to attend HOD/HOY detention; persistent or extreme poor behaviour; misbehaviour in the Intervention Room. ON CALL

Anti-social behaviour outside of lesson; truancy; high level disruption eg. Rudeness, aggression, etc; repeated misbehaviour as listed below; failure to attend detention. **ON CALL**

Using moble phone or technologies, repeated failure to hand in homework/classwork; insolence; refusal to comply with request of member of staff; repeated lateness. This sanction also applies for any of the issues below if higher level or continuing to reoccur

Late to lesson; inadequate or incomplete homework, classwork, coursework, NOT following WINSTANLEY WAY; offensive language; recurrence of behaviours listed below

Low level disruption - eg. pen tapping; swinging on chair; talking without permission; lack of equipment inc Chromebook not charged
