Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination to protect against various cancers

We would like to offer all young people in school year 8 (aged 12 to 13 years) the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination in school.

The vaccination offers protection against upto nine HPV strains, which can cause various cancers. It is a two dose course given as an injection in the upper arm, six to 24 months apart. - You will need the code for your school. For **Winstanley School** the school code is **LE143844**
- **You only need to submit your decision once for the full-course of vaccinations.**
- You will receive a confirmation email when the form is submitted.

Will you vaccinate without a consent form? No.

When is the session? Your school will tell you the date we will visit.

When should I submit my response by? As soon as possible. The form will close ONE working day before the session. We will reopen it later so you can consent for future sessions.
