Dear Parents and Carers,

This term our pupils will be continuing with their 14-19 programmes. We are developing our garden areas, incorporating a whole host of work related learning skills. Pupils will be landscaping, cutting the grass, painting murals, designing and making some garden furniture and developing the area for wildlife. In Food Technology lessons, pupils will be learning the recipe for flapjacks and fajitas. Pupils will be shopping locally for ingredients, developing their numeracy skills and continuing to work on transitions.

In Science, pupils are learning the process for growing cress and will be designing a range of cress heads. They will also be learning how to make bath bombs, which may become part of our enterprise work, selling them in a pop-up shop. In Art, pupils are designing and working with materials related to our whole Hillcrest stories topic. Pupils will be representing Alice in Wonderland through a range of mediums.

Pupils will work on their IEP and therapy targets through all their lessons. Pupil interests are a large part of their individual curriculum. Pupils are developing their Maths and English skills by using their own interests for engagement and building skills. The class will continue to learn communication and transition skills at community venues, such as cafe, shopping and sports.
