Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you had a lovely Easter, and managed to enjoy some of the warmer weather we are finally receiving. Welcome to the Summer term, where our topic will be 'Alice in Wonderland', where many of our activities within sessions will be inspired by this.

This term our team is Ruth, Megan, Ellen, Kirsty, Vicky, Donna, Phoebe, Kat, Dave, Tim, Ruh, Katie and Joanne. Speech and Language Therapy continues to be provided by Erin Kelly and Occupational Therapy, Gemma Cooke.

This term, our focus for learning will include; Shapes and their Properties in Maths, and English will continue to take place twice per week, where one session is writing focussed and the other has a focus on reading. In science pupils will be participating in experiments linked to natural disasters such as earthquakes and tsunamis, and in RE pupils are learning about signs and symbols found throughout different religions. RSE will continue from last term where pupils learn about the environments in the wider world, human impact on the environment, and also thinking about our local environment (and how we can help to take care of it). We will be creating our own Mad Hatter's tea party during food technology, where pupils will be invited to make party foods such as sandwiches, sausage rolls and mini pizzas!

Pupils will continue to have the opportunity to access the community three times per week, where they will be transferring their communication and numeracy skills during shopping and cafe based sessions. In addition to this, pupils' wellbeing and physical health is a focus during our community outings on Wednesdays.

Therapy will continue to be integrated as part of the school day and in community outings. Therapy sessions will focus on peer interaction as well as exploring emotions.
