




He was taught to play the piano by his mother. Traditional Norwegian music was very important to him and these melodies influenced his music. He was asked to write music for a play called Peer Gynt. The opening movement: Morning and In the Hall of the Mountain King are often played by Orchestras around the world. After he died his music was considered old fashioned but he influenced the music of the French composer of the 20th Century.</i></p> <p>Year 1- Year 6</p>

People faced poverty and racism and blues music reflected this. Features of blues music can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk About It Why do think the blues got their name? a sad subject matter syncopation low bass notes that 'walk' up and then down improvisation Usually in jazz, lots of musicians can improvise at the same time but in blues music, it is normally one musician and for a shorter time. <p>Popular blues songs from the 1920s include 'Rhapsody in Blue' by George Gershwin, 'Deep Moaning Blues' by Ma Rainey and 'St Louis Blues' by Bessie Smith.</p> <p>Year 6</p>
