Dear Parent/ Carer.

We are concerned that the high standards of uniform that we saw in September are now slipping. In signing the home - school agreement, you agreed that you would work with us to ensure that your child was always in uniform.

Initially can I thank the vast majority of parents who are supporting our uniform policy, we really appreciate your help.

BUT

We need to ensure that every Year 7 is in perfect uniform on the 5th January 2021. We know it has been a very difficult year, so if you are struggling with this, please let us know before Christmas and we will support you with the purchase of particular items.

Key reminders:

- Students should be in school trousers NOT leggings or jogging bottoms
- Skirts should knee length
- Students should be in black polishable shoes NOT black canvas trainers or suede
- Students MUST bring a mask every day we are having to give lots out every day
- Students should have natural coloured hair it must be dyed back over the holiday if this is not the case. We are willing to buy a colour remover for hair if parents cannot afford to do this
- Students are allowed one small pair of stud earrings all other piercings should be removed e.g. nose studs, additional earrings
- No nail extensions, overlays or acrylics
- No false eyelashes

If there are issues with uniform e.g. the sole of a shoe comes off and they cannot be replaced until the weekend, the student should bring a note into school or the parent can call the school in advance.
