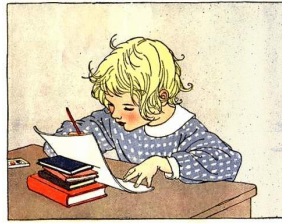


## Home learning for year 3 17<sup>th</sup> October 2014 .

- Label your graph ie Block graph to show.....
- Draw your graph using a ruler.
- Colour your blocks carefully so your data is clear.

- 3) How many people drive petrol and diesel cars?
- 4) How many people drive Electric and Hybrid cars?
