8. Do you have any other comments you would like us to consider in finalising the design proposals?

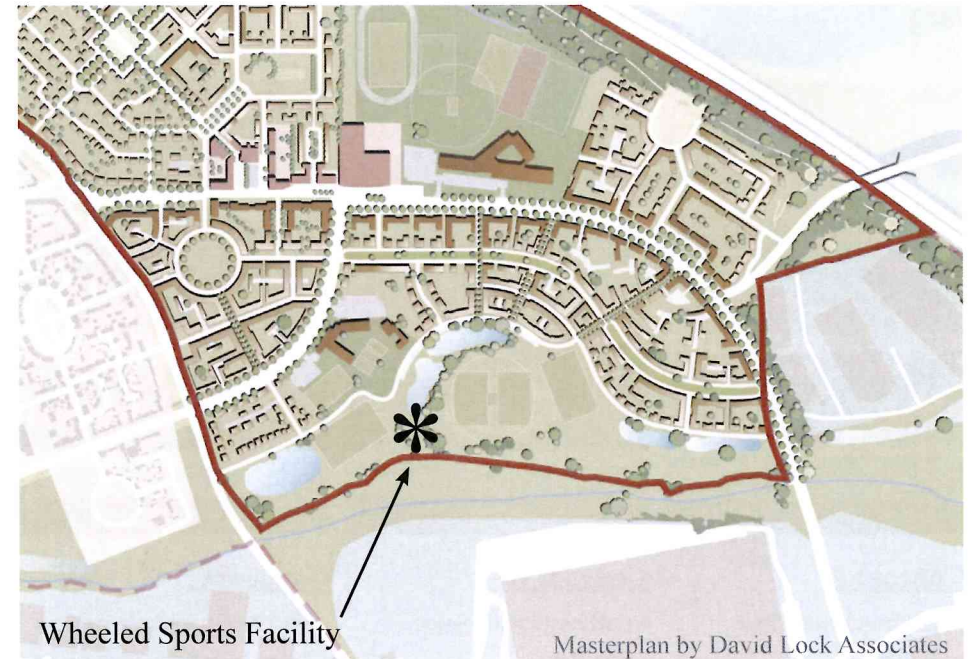

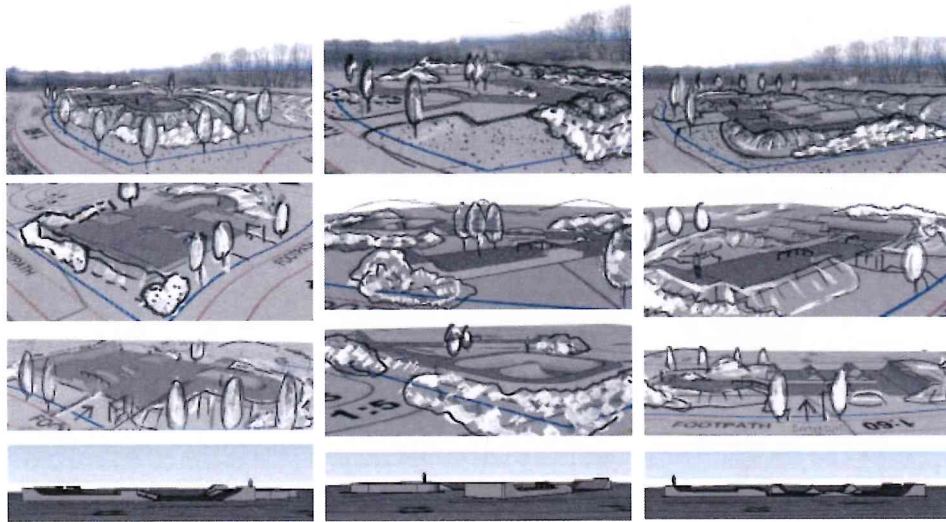

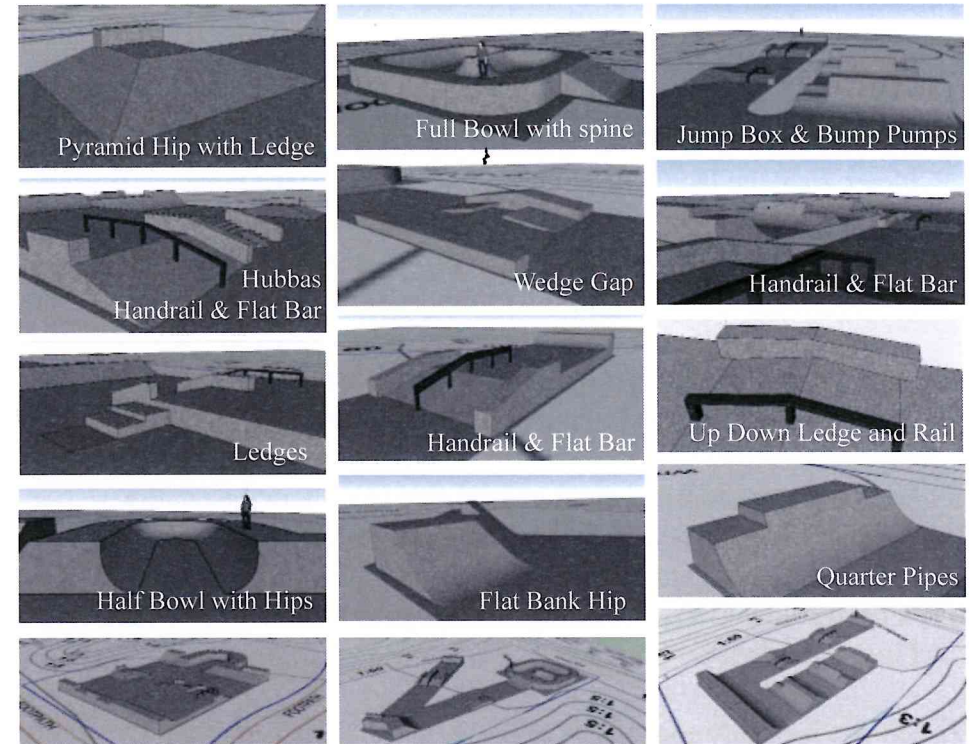
