### Latest News

**School Dinners:** We are moving to an online ordering system for school dinners. You must register by 10th July at **https://mealordering.bluerunner.co.uk/** as there will no longer be a paper option for ordering meals come September. When registering, please tick the box to receive updates as you will not be able to add children to your account until 1st August. By ticking this box, it will enable you to receive an email prompt from Chartwells to then add children and their class on that date.

**Class Photos:** Orders for class photos must be returned to school by <u>9am Monday 6th July</u>. Alternatively, you may order online by using the code on the back of the photo proof.

**Year 3 Swimming:** Year 3 will have a water safety session next week on Monday and Tuesday. Please send children in with long pyjamas in addition to their normal swim kit. 
