September Nursery Places: For those who have received an offer of a Nursery place (initially those living in catchment with a sibling attending Brooklands) Monday 14th March is the cut off for returning acceptance slips.

Nursery Reminder: Children need to have spare clothes every day in case they get wet or muddy outside. Please include a plastic bag for any wet items as well. Children will also need waterproof coats and wellies for especially rainy days.

Sleep Workshop: There will be a drop in session for parents on Wednesday 23rd March in the small hall at Countess Way at $2: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ for families who are struggling with a child's sleep patterns such as refusing to go to bed, waking up in the night or getting up too early.
