Free School Meals and Pupil Premium: Parents and carers are now able to check eligibility and apply for free school meals and pupil premium through a newly launched eligibility checker. The checker, which is part of a new Citizen Portal, allows parents and carers to enter their details and find out within a few minutes if their child qualifies for free meals or if the school qualifies for pupil premium.

To check eligibility, all applications now need to be made through the Citizen Portal. This replaces the paper application form that was previously used to apply for free school meals. The Citizen Portal can be found at:


Pin Assemblies
