Deadline for Nursery Applications: The closing date for nursery applications is <u>Monday 29th February</u>.

Year 1 Fen Street Donations Needed: The Year team at Fen Street are looking for donations of yoghurt pots and cotton wool as they are hoping to make cress heads as part of their project learning.

Foundation 2 Fen Street Donations Needed: The Foundation team at Fen Street are looking for donations of toilet rolls, bottle tops, plant pots, soil and sticks.

Unnamed Items: Please, please, please be sure to clearly label all of your child's items, especially coats and lunchboxes. This time of year, when the sun is shining they tend to take their coats off on the playground. If they are clearly named they can easily be returned. We have also had a bit of a mix up this week with unnamed lunchboxes. Quite a lot of children have the same lunchbox, therefore if they are not named it may result in another child mistakenly eating someone else's lunch!

Chartwells Meal Ordering: We've had a number of children that have not had meals ordered not just this week but in previous weeks. If you have missed the cut-off or have forgotten to order you must send your child in with a packed lunch—even if they come under the universal free school meal scheme. If no order is placed, the kitchen will not have ordered enough which will result in them coming up short for portions. Chartwells School Meals Price Increase: We have received notification that Chartwells will increase their price from £2.20 per meal to £2.30 from Monday 4th April 2016. This will not affect free school meals.

Cancelling Hot Dinners: If your child is attending a school trip and you have ordered a hot dinner for that day you will need to cancel that order whether it is a universal free school meal or a paid for meal. This can be done online through your Bluerunner account by 9am the Thursday before or by phoning the Chartwells customer care line on 01908 615705.


