Dear Parents/Carers,

We have reviewed our procedure for opening our school gates in the morning. For the purpose of safeguarding we will not be opening the gates at Countess Way until 8:10am as well as the top and front gates at Fen Street until 8:20am. Children who walk themselves to school should not be arriving before these times. If you need to access our Fen Street campus before 8:20am you may use the redway that runs from Newport Road to Fen Street. This will not affect Nursery drop off and pick up.

We have been told that the section of Fen Street which runs across Broughton Grounds Lane will open the week before half term. This will inevitably increase the traffic flow in front of our Fen Street campus. Please be cautious of this change when crossing Fen Street as well as entering/exiting the car park.

This week you will have received a data collection form home in your child's book bag. Please ensure you have completed every section and return it to the front office as soon as possible as we are now required to return pupils' country of birth and nationality on our Autumn census.

You will also have received a one-off consent form for school visits. This form replaces the permission letters sent out before each trip. Please complete one form for each of your children so that we may keep it on file for this academic year.

Ignite: The £35 Ignite contribution is now available to pay via ParentPay. This is an easy way to make your contribution towards our Ignite programme. Free School Meals and Pupil Premium: Parents and carers are now able to check eligibility and apply for free school meals and pupil premium through a newly launched eligibility checker. The checker, which is part of a new Citizen Portal, allows parents and carers to enter their details and find out within a few minutes if their child qualifies for free meals or if the school qualifies for pupil premium.

To check eligibility, all applications now need to be made through the Citizen Portal. This replaces the paper application form that was previously used to apply for free school meals. The Citizen Portal can be found at:


Pin Assemblies
