Hot Dinner Order Forms: A number of parents are still turning in their order forms late or not at all. The deadline to return forms is always by **4pm the Wednesday before** the week you are ordering for and <u>no later</u>. Orders returned on Thursday, Friday or even the Monday the following week <u>will not be accepted</u> and you will need to provide a packed lunch for your child that week, this is regardless of whether they receive a free lunch under the Universal Free School Meal scheme or not. Cygnet runs on a **pre-order** system, not an order-on-the-day system. Therefore, even if your child receives a free lunch it still must be pre-ordered.


Hay Fever: Please be aware that we can only administer prescribed medications. If your child suffers from hay fever we cannot administer over the counter antihistamines. Keep in mind that we have open fields surrounding the school therefore it may be a good idea to keep an eye on the pollen count and dose your child accordingly.
