

At School	At Home
 We are learning to write our names. Can your child recognise their name? Can your child write their name? Can your child correctly form the letters in their name? (lower case) We are learning to recognise numbers in the environment. Does your child understand that numbers represent amounts? Can your child recognise numbers to 20? Can your child put the numbers from 0-20 in the right order? We are learning to talk about where we come from. Can your child talk about their family? Can your child talk about special events that you celebrate in your family? 	 Practise writing their name using different pens and pencils. Use a highlighter to write your child's name and encourage them to copy. Messy is fun! Have a go at writing their name in flour or sauce with their finger. Spot the letters in your child's name in books and signs. Talk about different people who help us in our community, draw pictures, make the different vehicles. Spot numbers in the environment e.g. on signs shopping, house numbers, bus stops etc Match numbers to their amounts. e.g. find number 6 and count out 6 objects. Count jumps, claps, steps to 20. We are learning these sounds: s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, ck, e,u
