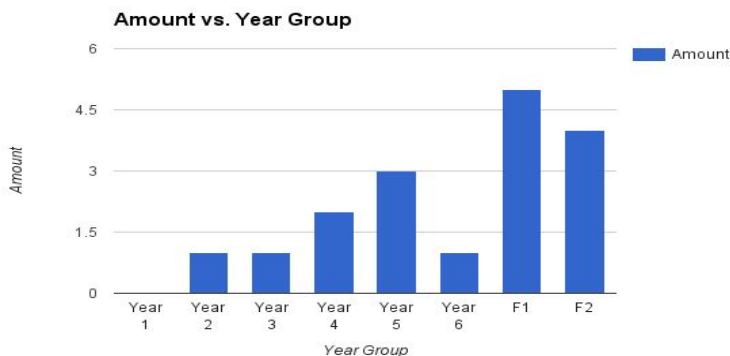


EAL New Arrival Children July 2016

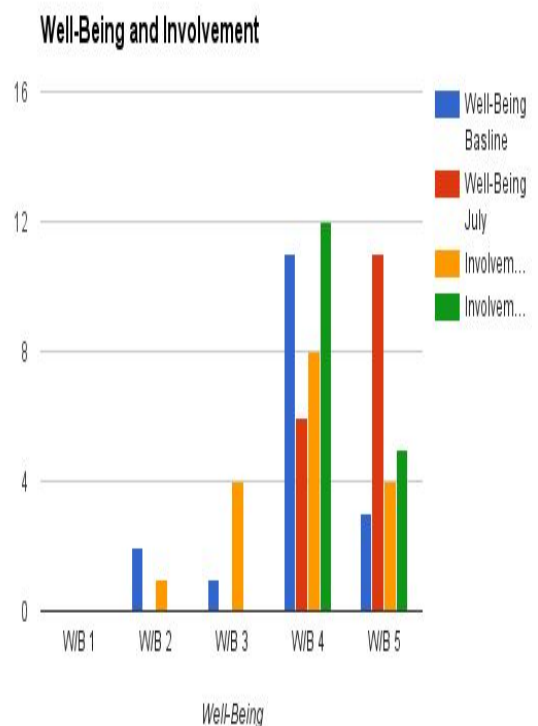


This is the current data obtained in July from a staff shared document monitoring form.

39% EAL Children attended at the school after the Academic school year began in September.

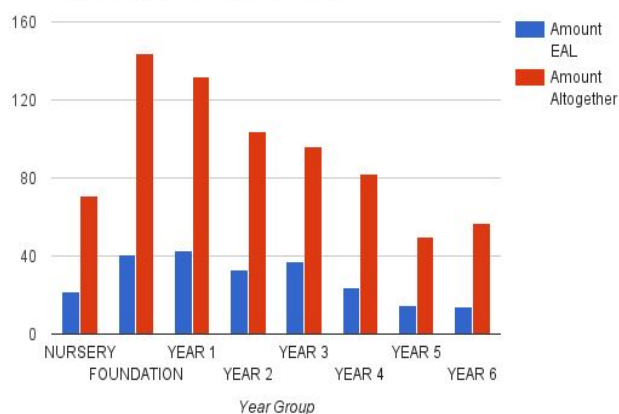

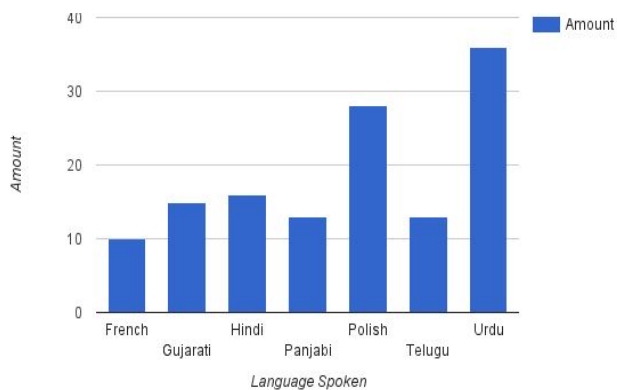
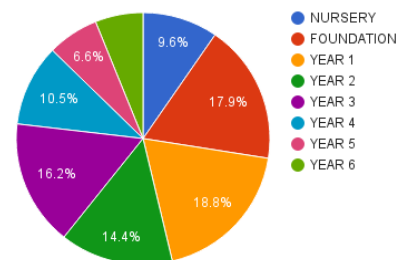

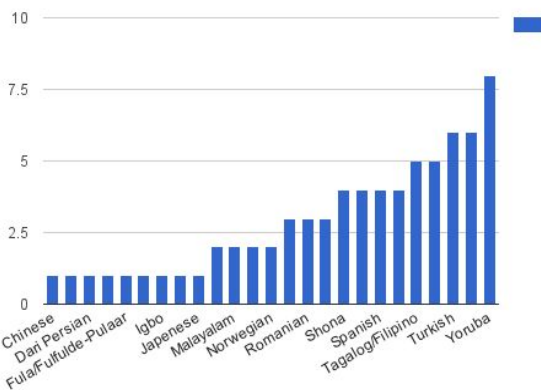
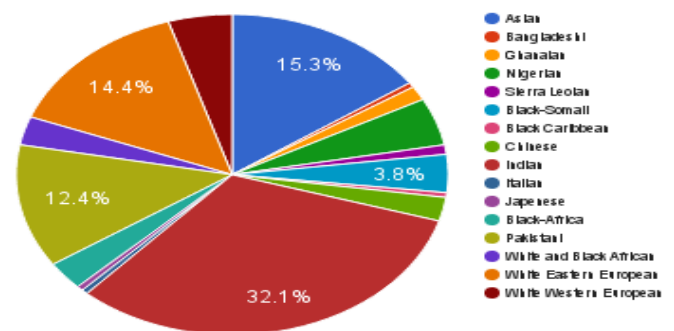
Amount EAL and Amount Altogether

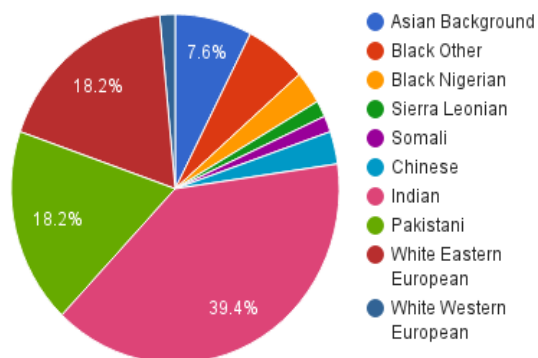
Whole School Ethnicity
