These children will look at Tell Me Tuesday information, attend the meeting with the new children and help raise issues and find solutions together.
	Year 3/4 Role	Anti- Bullying Ambassador/ Restorative Practice Leader	The role of an Anti-Bullying Ambassador is to ensure that bullying never occurs in our community and uphold our values of respect and inclusion. The role of a Restorative Practice Leader is to ensure a harmonious community that is open, honest and believes in inclusion.
	Year 4 Role	Front Desk Support	The role of the Front Desk Support is to play a vital role in ensuring our school runs effectively and to support the front desk staff with jobs around the school You will need good communication skills and the ability to work collaboratively with your peers and staff within school.
Upper Key Stage 2 Roles	Year 5 Role	School Council	Year 5 children will have the opportunity to be a part of a Leadership Project to make a change to the community and school. They will also ensure our school ethos 'OPEN, GROW and BELIEVE' is at the heart of everything we do. Children in the school council are representatives of their peers and help raise issues and find solutions together.
	Year 5/6 Role	Sports Leaders/ Playground Leaders	The role of Sports Leaders is to ensure that outside areas are well organised, planned and behaviour is good. Sports Leaders have responsibility to lead sport during break time and lunchtime. They may be asked to support Sports Day, Sports Festivals and come up with inter school competitions throughout the year. They will be promoting a physically active lifestyle to all.
Across the school	Across the School (2 children per class)	Reading Ambassadors	The role of a Reading Ambassador is to ensure that we promote reading so that everyone enjoys reading. They are responsible for keeping the class reading area tidy, as well as the libraries tidy.
	Across the School (2 children per class)	LEAN Manager	The role of the LEAN Manager is to make sure that they classroom is kept tidy. They are also responsible for ensuring the class has enough resources to work effectively.
	Across the School (2 children per class)	Digital Angels	The role of the Digital Angel is to ensure that the class devices are monitored and kept safe. They should also bring any new apps for learning to the teachers attention. They may also engage with parents when we ask them our Tell Me Tuesday questions each week.
