## What are Cambridge Nationals

- They are challenging and well respected qualifications equivalent to GCSEs.
- Instead of being $100 \%$ exam, they feature coursework and internally assessed units which may suit some students better.
- They provide you with knowledge and highly sought-after skills.
- They provide access to A Levels and degree programmes in most colleges and universities.
- Faculty Leaders can help decide which is the best course for students to pursue.

## Subjects with more than one course

- You cannot select two courses of the same or very similar subject as your main choices.
- You can select one as a main choice and one as a reserve though.
- E.g. You can select Cambridge National Engineering Design as a main choice and GCSE Engineering as a reserve choice. They cannot both be chosen as main choices.
- The same applies to the two PE courses, to GCSE Computer Science and Cam Nat IT, to GCSE Sociology and Cam Nat Health \& Social Care, to Fine Art and Photography and to Economics and Business Studies.


## Will students get their first choices?

- $91 \%$ of students received all their main choices last year
- There will be some combinations that cannot work on the timetable
- A subject may have too many students so we use order of preference and student information from the course leaders to allocate places
- A student has to meet entry requirements for certain subjects
- Students should list choices in order of preference

## What are the core subjects?

- Maths
- English language
- English literature
- Science (Combined or Separate)
- Mandarin or German or Spanish
- Core PE
- PSHCE


## Can a student pick Separate Sciences?

No. The Faculty Leader for Science decides which students are able to achieve well doing the Separate Science qualifications

- Separate Science is high challenge
- Combined Science has increased significantly in challenge
- Both are excellent preparation for A Level
- Key assessments will determine a student's suitability for Separate Sciences at GCSE


## Can a student change the language?

- no, students must continue with the language they studied at KS3
- you can do community languages
