



# Subjects with more than one course

- You **cannot** select two courses of the same or very similar subject as your main choices.
- You can select one as a main choice and one as a reserve though.
- E.g. You can select GCSE Art as a main choice and GCSE Photography as a reserve choice. They cannot both be chosen as main choices.
- The same applies to GCSE Economics and Business Studies.
- To maximise choices available Post 16 we recommend choosing a range of subjects from different disciplines: consider doing at least one creative subject, one of the Humanities, a language and something practical.

# Languages

- You can only select one language (German, Mandarin or Spanish) and that should be the one you are studying at the Academy now.
- You cannot select one of these languages if you are not studying it at the Academy now. If you want to discuss this, then please speak to the Faculty Leader for Languages, Mr Hillage.
- GCSE exams in community languages can be sat at the Academy. The Faculty Leader for Languages will advertise this to parents and students next Academic year.

# Will students get their first choices?

- 92% of students received all their main choices last year
- There will be some combinations that cannot work on the timetable
- A subject may have too many students so we use order of preference and student information from the course leaders to allocate places
- A student has to meet entry requirements for certain subjects
- **Students should list choices in order of preference**
- We will always seek to give students their first choice and their second and third choice.

# Two Important Reminders:

1. Make your choices in your order of preference. You first click is your first choice.
2. Meet the deadline: **Monday 16th March.**
3. If you have not selected 6 options by the deadline (4 choices + 2 reserves) you will need to choose **AFTER** the subject have been placed in timetable blocks.
4. This will limit your choice and some subjects will be full.

# Key Date 5: Monday 16th March

- Options Online closes for students.
- You will need to have made your choices.
- You will need to have checked your choices.
- You will need to have listed your options in order of preference.

# Key Date 5: Wednesday 18th March

- Parents will be sent a letter listing students' options choices.
- If you want to change an option choice at that point the parent should email Ms Maskell.
- After this date there will be no opportunity to change options or choose different subjects.
- **It is important to discuss the choices and consider carefully the right options.**






**Successful transition from Y9 to Y10**

# The timeline to bridge the gap (first round)

1. **March 2026:** Choose subjects via SIMS Options.
2. **April/May 2026:** Year 9 options **agreed** in partnership with Faculty Leaders.
3. **June 2026:** Year 9 options **shared** with students and carers/parents.
4. **June 2026:** **First survey** (Google Forms) allowing students to request some **subject changes** at this point we will only change reserve choices.
5. **July 2026:** Subject options process has been **completed**.

# The timeline to bridge the gap (second round)

1. **September 2026:** students need to follow their Key Stage 4 **timetables** for **two weeks**.
2. **September 2026** : **Second survey** allowing students to request **subject changes**.
3. **September 2026:** Changes **reviewed** with senior leaders and faculty leaders.
4. **September 2026:** final subject changes **communicated** to students and carers/parents.
5. **From 1st October 2026:** students will be unable to request changes.

# A focused GCSE

- **Subject selection (options)** will define the study path in Y10 and Y11
- A more **specialised** and **deep curriculum** aligned to individual interests.
- **Organisation** and **hard work** will contribute toward successful learning.
- Increased expectations for **independent study**.
- Greater emphasis on **exam preparation** to improve routines and sustain knowledge.


# Can a student pick Separate Sciences?

# How can you help your child decide?
