### Re: Transition to Blackwood Comprehensive School 2021

Firstly, I would like to welcome your child to Blackwood Comprehensive School. We are very much looking forward to meeting and working with you, and developing and sharing your child's educational experience over the next five years. The transition from primary to secondary school is an important stage in the lives of children and their families and we pride ourselves on providing a smooth and extensive transition programme, which ensures that pupils arrive on their first day in September excited about the next chapter of their education rather than apprehensive.

However, we recognise that the current situation may be challenging for Year 6 pupils and their families and we want to reassure you that we will do everything in our power to make the transition to Blackwood Comprehensive School a smooth one. Consequently, I am writing to outline our transition plan for the summer term (restrictions allowing) and also to share the extra support that we will be providing. We hope that this will help to reassure you all.

Information has been placed on the school website under '**Transition**', there are various resources to help and support your child's transition. This includes welcome videos by key staff, a virtual tour of our school and a welcome pack specifically for your child to help ease their transition. You will also find copies of key documentation and other important information.

Your child may have already mentioned that they have met me. Over the past four weeks I have visited all of our feeder primary schools and some out of catchment primary schools. It was a pleasure to meet our prospective pupils and nearly all of them are looking forward to, and excited about, their transition to us. Mrs Colley and Mr Williams (Year 7 Progress Managers), Mrs Rudman (ALNCO) and myself have been working closely with your child's Year 6 teachers to ensure that we receive all the necessary information to support their academic progress. We are also working remotely with primary school staff to ensure your child is discussed individually and key information about their progress is shared with us.

#### Year 7 Virtual Transition Meeting – date to be confirmed.

In July, parents, carers and pupils will be invited to a Year 7 transition meeting where we will share a presentation about the transition process and how your child will be taught at Blackwood Comprehensive







School. It will also be an opportunity to meet key members of staff including our two Year 7 Progress Managers (Mrs Colley and Mr Williams) and Year 7 form tutors, who will be there to support your child while they take this important milestone. During this evening, you will also get the opportunity to ask questions to allow for a smooth transition.

### Blackwood Summer Transition Afternoon - Monday 5th July - Friday 16th July 2021

Due to covid restrictions each primary school will be attending on a specific day in their bubbles. *Dates to be confirmed.* 

On their identified day, pupils will visit Blackwood Comprehensive School between 1.30pm - 3.30pm. Transport will be provided from their primary school but we would like parents/carers to collect their child at 3.30pm from the entrance at Ty-isha Terrace. The afternoon will include:

- A welcome meeting/ presentation by key staff
- A performance by our Year 10 Music & Performing Arts pupils
- A meeting with form tutors
- A tour around the school
- A question and answer session
