A young carer is someone under 18 who is caring, unpaid, for a family member or friend who is ill, frail, disabled or has mental health or addiction problems. They often take on practical and/or emotional caring responsibilities that would normally be expected of an adult. Research suggests there are at least 800,000 young carers in the UK but many do not realise they are a young carer.

We know that young carers may need a little extra support to enjoy and do well at school. At **Blackwood Comprehensive School** we are committed to ensuring that all pupils who are young carers are identified, and supported effectively.

As the Young Carers' Lead, Mrs Griffiths, Mrs Ridout and Mrs Pitt we have a responsibility for ensuring all young carers are able to enjoy school and make good progress.
