The Canteen

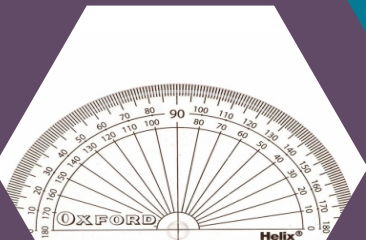

School Uniform



Our School Uniform

- *Black school blazer with the school badge
 - *Plain white shirt (short or long sleeve)
 - *Plain charcoal smart trousers (black canvas, skinny trousers or jeans may not be worn) or charcoal grey, knee length, pleated skirt
 - *Plain dark grey or black socks
 - *Plain black shoes, leather with black soles and no decorative stitching or carrying an explicit sports logo. (Black boots, trainers, plimsolls, canvas or suede shoes may not be worn. Acceptable shoes are defined by the school)
 - *School tie
 - *V-neck plain black school jumper with the school badge (optional item)
- PLEASE NOTE** - Denim jackets and coats that the school deems as "hoodies" are not permitted

HAIR

- *Extreme styles and hair colouring (as defined by the school) will not be permitted
- *Shaved lines in hair or eyebrows are not permitted

JEWELLERY-TATTOOS-PIERCINGS

- *One pair of stud earrings may be worn. Students are not allowed; facial studs, ear expanders or any other form of earring. Rings and bracelets may not be worn.

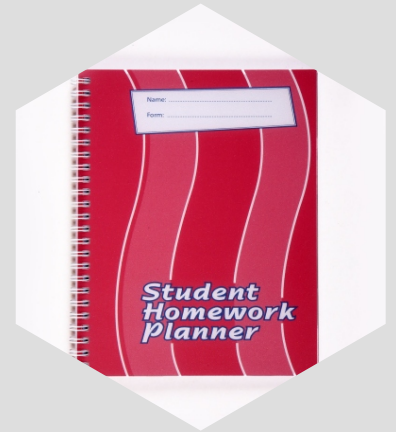

Top Tips



* *Make good use of the **HOMework PLANNER** that is given to you by your Form Tutor. It has lots of information in it including: your timetable, important dates, school rules, uniform and much more.*



* *Pack your school bag the night before. Use your planner to check the lessons that you have for that day. Make sure you have your pencil case and all your books.*

* *If you have forgotten your book then tell your teacher at the start of lesson. You will need to work on paper and then "copy up" into your book that evening.*



* *Always write down your homework in your **HOMework PLANNER**. This will stop you forgetting. It is also a very good idea to complete your homework the day you have it where possible. This will stop work from piling up and causing stress and anxiety.*



Top Tips



** Your planner will need to be signed by your parents each week, this will be checked by your Form Tutor who will also sign it.*



** Always arrive early. It is better to be 10 minutes early than 10 minutes late. Being on time is important in school and also when you get a job. Start good practice now.*

** If you are late for some reason then you must go to Reception to get your mark when you arrive.*



** If you are ill and unable to come to school then an adult from home must ring the school as soon as possible (before 10:30am). This will prevent calls being made over truancy concerns. It is also very helpful for your Form Tutor if you can get an adult at home to write a note in your planner as well as ringing the school.*

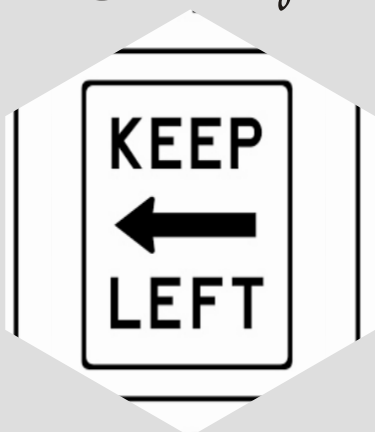
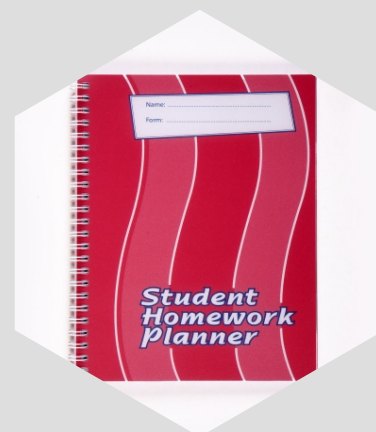


Top Tips



* Attendance at school is very important. Where possible we would encourage that medical appointments be made out of school time. This will reduce disruption to your learning.

* Please take time to read through the key pages of your planner when you get it. Pay particular attention to the "Do's and Don'ts", "The School Rules" and information on "School Uniform".



* In the corridors walk on the **LEFT** hand side and please follow the signs in main block for the **ONE WAY SYSTEM** on the stairs. This is for your safety.

* Mobile phones and tablets are **NOT ALLOWED** in school. If they are seen they will be confiscated and a parent will have to come up the school to collect it. Don't bring large amounts of money to school. If you bring money in for a trip then give it to your Form Tutor straight away.



* If you have any problems, you lose something or someone is picking on you then please **TELL A MEMBER OF STAFF**. We are here for you, we will help and support you.

- * Sports Day*

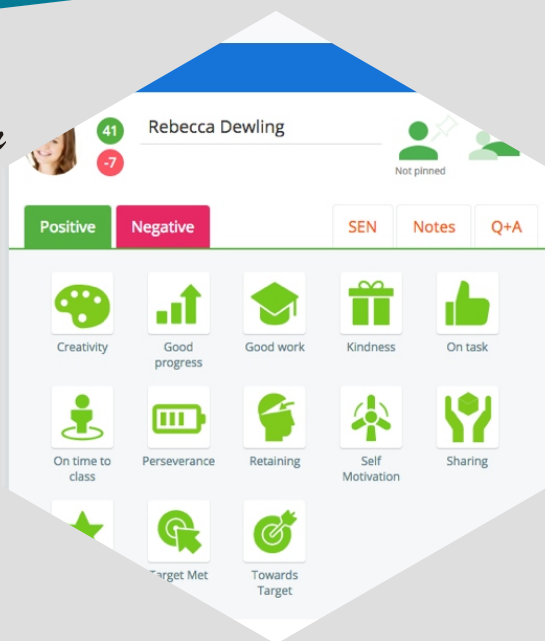
