Dear Parents & Carers,

Given the update from the government yesterday related to social distancing measures and increased self-isolation guidance, I am writing to keep you up to date with the school's current position.

We currently remain open in line with the national guidance. We are also taking additional measures to reduce any possibility of transmission of Covid-19.

The guidance changed to advise people that *'if you or anyone in your home has a high temperature or a new and continuous cough, then you should stay at home for 14 days'.*

Additional actions we are taking at school are:

- Stopping whole school worship and making it class based
- Rescheduling or postponing any trips, visits, visitors or events
- Cancelling swimming

We are all following government advice and continue to advise staff and children presenting with any symptoms to stay at home. We have many pupils and 2 members of staff, now at home. This doesn't mean they have Covid-19, it simply means that we are following government guidance to ensure the school community is as safe as possible in the current situation.

The whole school community is working together to ensure the school is open, operational and safe, as per the national guidance. This includes ensuring that our governing body are informed and updated with regards to the changing situation.

As we remain open we welcome any pupil, who is currently fit and well, into school, continuing our work to support our community. When, and if, school closures happen this will be the point at which we will share 'Home learning' activities.
