Dear Parents,

We have been organising the re-opening of the school for all year groups. From next week we will have some children in school from each year group. Thank you for getting back to us with your decisions for the end of the year.

We have now made our final plans.

We have approximately 50% of our children back at school on a part time basis. This means we have the space and time to keep everyone safe.

For those of you at home here are the plans for the final few weeks...and some thoughts about September.

Learning for children at home:

Wednesday 24th June:

We will be opening the playground for you to collect your children's work i.e. Art/DT/ exercise books

We also need you to look at home for any books belonging to school and return them.

Please come at the following times to collect and return:

Year Reception and Year 6	10.00
Years 1 and 2	10.30
Year 3 and 4	11.00
Year 5	11.30

Children will continue to receive the Padlett learning they have received recently as well as the phone calls and Zoom meetings. From 29th June all teachers will be teaching a 'bubble' of children in school; some of them will be teaching for 4 days in school. This means we are going to get creative with the work we are sending home:

Week beginning 29 th June	<u>Transition Week:</u> You will meet your new teacher on Monday 29 th June. They will send you a video message. They will also be part of your weekly Zoom class meeting. Your teacher will set you transition work, just like the work you do in school during our transition week.
Week beginning 6 th July	<u>Sports Week:</u> It should have been sports day! Mr Pastore will set you sports challenges this week.
Week beginning 13 th July	<u>The last week of term:</u>

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Communicating with school:

We encourage you to email or phone the office rather than come into school. You may also continue to communicate with your child's class teacher as you have done recently. Please be aware they are now in school teaching so they may not get back to you as quickly!

The school grounds are now a parent-free zone which goes against our usual friendly and welcoming practice. We are significantly restricting the number of visitors on site. Please make all contact with school either by telephone or the admin email.

Changes in Plans

The government's plans have been challenged by unions. At this point in time, we are unaware that this has changed the government's stance and so we've continued with our planning; we need to make sure we are prepared and that our parents are informed. However, should there be any change in position, we will let you know as soon as we can.

September:

We are still waiting for information about September. At time of writing this we believe the Government will encourage schools to be back to normal. We really hope so! I will write to you as soon as I know what the plans are.
