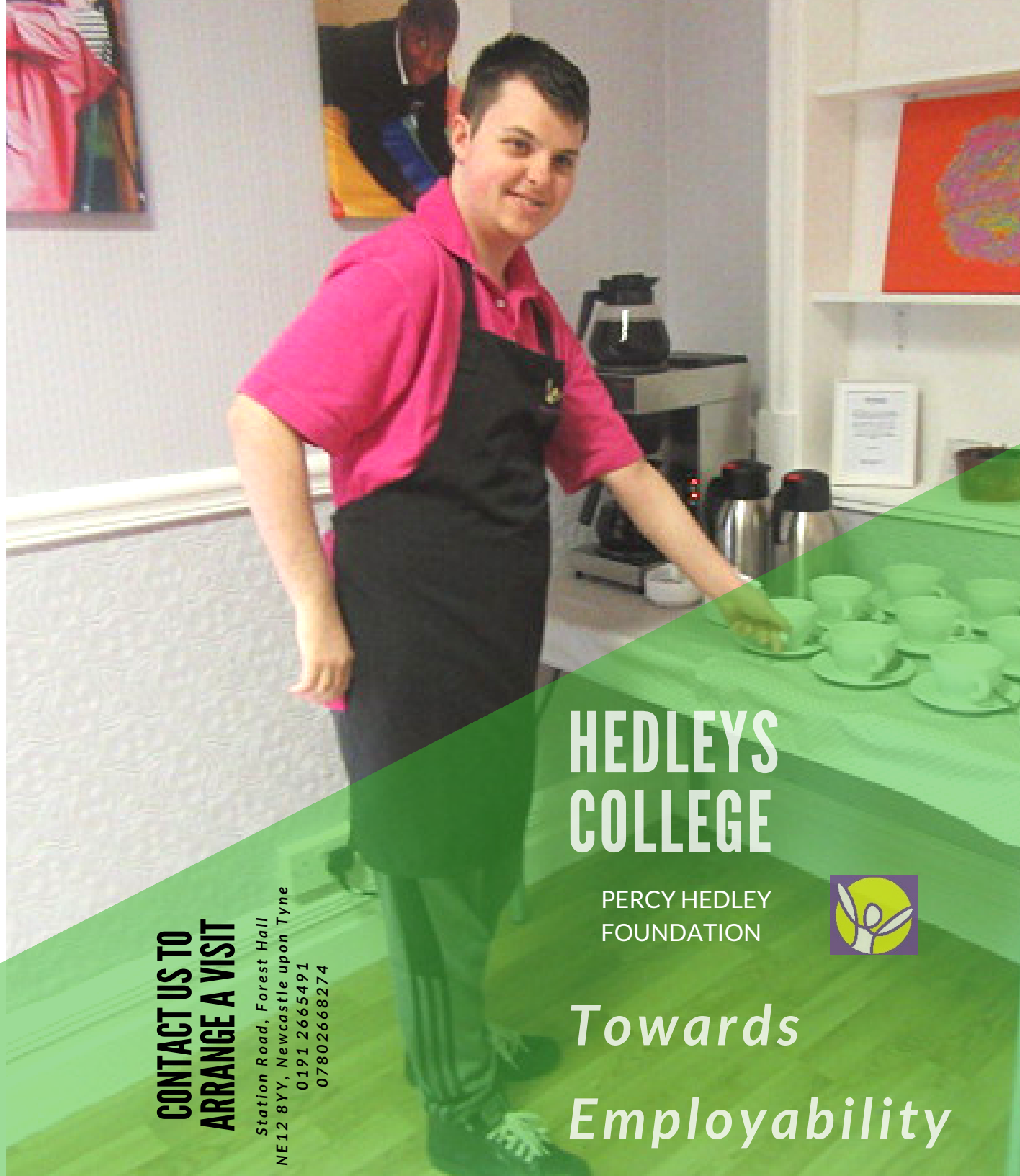

Progression would be Hedleys Foundation for Work and Supported Internship Learning Programmes.
