


Shipston High: Geography Curriculum

Challenges & opportunities in the UK

Pupils will learn latitude and longitude to locate physical landscapes, learn the theory of plate tectonics and the hazards associated with different plate boundaries. Pupils will study extreme weather events such as tropical storms

The People of the UK

Pupils will learn the UK has a diverse population which has changed over time. A census is taken every ten years to measure the UK population. Pupils will consider the influences due to UK having an ageing population; presenting opportunities and challenges.
