**Stratford Girls' Grammar School**



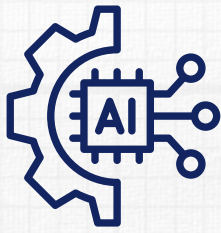
## OUR UNITED AIMS FOR 2024-25

## GOALS ALREADY ACHIEVED!

Work is already underway and the Alliance has made progress in the following areas:



### DEVELOPING PEDAGOGY AND BEST PRACTICE IN THE USE OF AI

A conference held at KES in January '24 focused on the digital transformation of education, covering AI in teaching, digital classrooms, digital citizenship and strategies for effective implementation.



### STRENGTHEN MIDDLE LEADERS EXPERTISE

A variety of network meetings and 'learning walks' have been conducted to share best practices in teaching and learning across the five schools and their subject departments.



### DEVELOP STUDENT COMMUNICATION THROUGH ORACY AND WIDER READING

Oracy sessions delivered at SGGS with a practical toolkit shared and plans to explore strengthening through extra-curricular fun, ie 'Monologue Slam', Comedy Club and debating competitions in the next academic year.

### DEVELOP STUDENT LEADERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

The Alliance hosted a successful Sustainability Conference in June 2024, which was well attended by Year 9 students. The students took the lead in creating a Sustainability Alliance logo and Policy.
