### **INTRODUCTION**

A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 30 April 2013 ("the Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as Graham James Primary Academy.



### **LEGAL AGREEMENT**

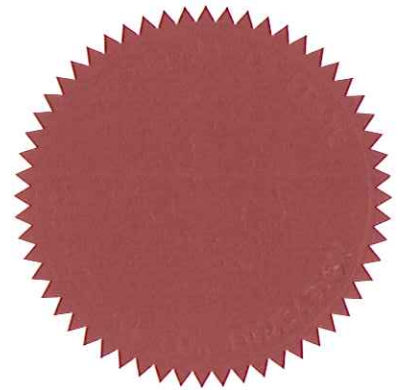
1. Any word or phrase used in this Deed shall, if that word or phrase is defined in the Funding Agreement, bear the meaning given to it in the Funding Agreement.

## **Schedule 1**

### Amendments to the Funding Agreement

1. Clause 17 of the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:

The planned capacity of the Academy is 480 in the age range 2-11 including a nursery of 60 places. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school whose requirements for:

- (a) the admission of pupils to the Academy are set out in Annex B to this Agreement;
- (b) the admission of the Academy of and support for pupils with SEN and with disabilities (for pupils who have and who do not have statements of SEN) are set out in Annex C to this Agreement;
- (c) pupil exclusions are set out in regulations made by virtue of section 51A of the Education Act 2002 (as may be amended from time to time, and includes any successor provisions).
