

**Choose a book and create a mini-project on it!**

Write some questions to the author or write to tell them what you thought about the book.

In year 5, we were going to read either Mr Stink or Danny Champion of the World. (See below)

But you can choose any book!

Read another book by the same author and make comparisons between the two stories.

Design a new front cover; compare it to other alternative front covers.

## Reading Project Ideas!

Create a comic strip showing the main parts of the story.

Draw the characters in the story using the description given by the author.

Act out a scene from the story; get your family members involved too! You could be the director of your own show!

Can you draw a scene from the story? If the description is a little vague, create your own scene!

If there is a film adaptation, write a comparison between film and text.

Continue the story: write the next chapter or write an alternative ending.

Look up new/exciting/tricky vocabulary in a dictionary and create a list of all the amazing new words you now know.

Re-tell the story from another point of view.

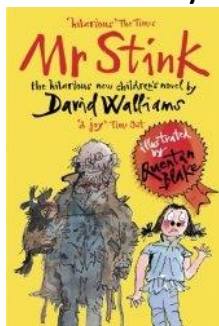
At the end of the first chapter, write a prediction. Think carefully about what might happen next. Then when you have finished the story, see how close your predictions were.

If you don't have any books at home, try looking online for a free e-book. Lots of companies are offering this at the moment!

Create a newspaper article about one of the main events in the story. Maybe a missing person report. Maybe a catch the villain report. Maybe a breaking news report of something never seen before!

**Maybe you could complete the project with a sibling. You could choose a book you would both enjoy!**

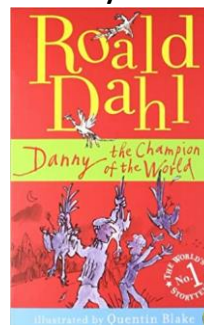
