Maths:

This week we are continuing to learn about 'greater than' 'less than' and 'equal to'. The children are being introduced to the symbols $<$ $>$ $=$

We are also going to be ordering objects using the phrases greatest and smallest.

Activities-

- Compare two numbers using the symbols.
Eg: $4 > 2$
- Three groups of objects. Children to order the groups with the greatest group first.
- To practice forming numbers correctly.

Writing:

- Practise spelling words:
van, vet, visit, will, win, wig.
- Practise spelling some Autumn phrases:
Noisy fireworks, smooth conkers, crunchy leaves.
- Practise forming the letters of the alphabet correctly.

Reading:

This week we are learning about prediction.

- Read school book every day! Discuss what has happened in the story. Ask questions about the story.
- Read stories to your child and ask questions about what they have heard.
- Read part of a story and ask you child to predict what they think will happen next.

Other:

- Draw pictures of animals that hibernates.
- Draw different outfits for different seasons.
- Listen to autumn songs: Autumn Days and Cauliflowers Fluffy.
