PARKING

There is <u>no</u> parking on the school grounds. We have had reports of Nursery parents parking in the disabled bay. Please note this is only for disabled badge holders. If you need to drive your child to school please park in the town centre car park.

UNIFORM

Please make sure that you label all of your child's uniform. Every day we are left with an un-named cardigan or jumper or two and it makes it difficult to return it to the owner when we have so many cardigans and jumpers which all look the same.

GARDEN TIME

Now that the colder weather is upon us please ensure that your child comes to nursery with a coat, hat and gloves.

The outside area is still an important part of children's learning and is used in all weathers apart from heavy rain.

TOYS

Please refrain from allowing your child to bring in toys from home. This can be very upsetting for them if the toys get broken or go missing.

CHRISTMAS PARTY

The Nursery Christmas party will take place on the morning and afternoon of Friday 17th December.

There will be a morning and afternoon party.

Invitations will be given out soon. Please check invitation to see if your child has been invited to the AM or PM party.

Party clothes can be worn on this day (this applies to Nursery children only).

Party food will be provided so a packed lunch is not required on this day.

JOLLY JUMPER DAY

On Friday 10th December we will be taking part in Jolly Jumper Day. Your child can come to Nursery wearing a Christmas jumper if they have one. There is no need to purchase one if you do not have one though.

Children do not have to wear uniform but we ask that they do not wear football kits.

We are asking for a suggested donation of \pounds 1.00 per child for wearing non uniform and this money will go to our chosen charities which will be announced soon.



CHRISTMAS PERFORMANCES
