

Understanding the world:

-To learn about different seasons and the changes that happen during Autumn in particular.

- -To look at the weather and how it changes in the Autumn.
- -To look closely at Autumn objects e.g. leaves, pine cones, conkers etc.
- -To go on an Autumn walk and collect some of our own Autumn leaves.

-Explore the habitat of The Gruffalo and the habitats of other woodland animals.

- -To look at hibernation and how and why animals do it.
- -To use 2simple to paint a Gruffalo Character.

Literacy:

- -Read the story of the Gruffalo.
- -Discuss the characters and setting of the Gruffalo story.
- -Order the story of the Gruffalo.
- -To look at Rhyming words and find words that Rhyme in the story.
- -To learn about speech bubbles and recall speech for different characters in the Gruffalo.
- -Name writing practise.



Expressive Art and Design: -Making leaf hedgehogs. -Painting some woodland animals and Gruffalo characters.

- -Colour and cut out Gruffalo masks.
- -Act out the story of the Gruffalo outside!
- -Leaf rubbing/printing.
- -Use playdough to make imaginary creatures

Physical Development:

-To explore different ways of travellingtravelling like the different Gruffalo characters.

- -To colour carefully within lines.
- -To use scissors with control to cut out masks.
- -To practise number and letter formation. -Pencil control sheets to develop pencil control

- -Work together with other children to retell the story of the Gruffalo.
- -To comment and share opinions on the Gruffalo story.
- -To talk about their knowledge of Autumn.
- -To show sensible behaviour when out on the Autumn walk

Communication and Language:



Mathematics:

-Vote for our favourite Gruffalo character.

-Accurately count various Autumn objects and write the correct numeral

- -Practise correct number formation
- -Begin to learn about simple adding counting to
- groups of objects together to find the total amount.
- -Put number 1-10 and then 1-20 in order.
- -To learn about and understand balance scales. -Order by size.
