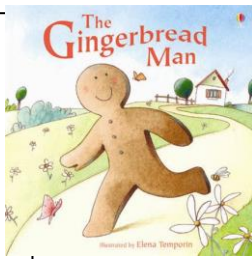


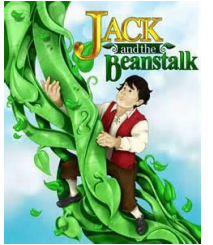
The Gingerbread Man:

Jack and the Beanstalk:

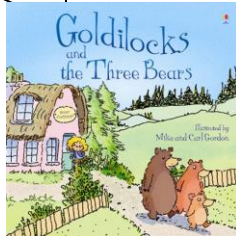
- Planting beans
