Vs Alligators</b></p> <p>Children should read through the text first.</p> <p>They can do 1 minute fluency – they read aloud for 1 minute and see how far they can read. They should read at least 120 words in that minute.</p>	<p>Writing –</p> <p>Children to watch John Lewis Christmas advert from 2017 as inspiration and a starting point for their writing. Children can decide how they want their story to go.
