Year 6 transition arrangements

From Monday 30th June 2025, as in previous years, each year group is transitioning to their next class. Year 6 will be moving out of their classrooms, and participating in more sports, computing and creative activities during this time.

Monday 30th June – Thursday 10th July

From Monday 30th June to Thursday 10th July (inclusive), Year 6 should come into school wearing P.E./sportswear, as part of each day will include sports activities. Children can wear their own sportswear, e.g. football kits, leggings, sweatshirts to school. Please ensure children dress according to the weather, e.g. hoodie, joggers, waterproof if cold and wet, as well as a refillable water bottle.

Friday 11th July – Last Day

Please ensure you child is in full school uniform on the last day of term – this will be expected for the Leavers' Assembly. If children would like their shirt signed on the last day, they should carry around a spare shirt to be signed, as children will need to wear a clean, white shirt for the Leavers' Assembly.

Doors will open at 1:30pm for Leavers' Assembly and the assembly is expected to commence by 2pm in the school hall and will conclude around 3pm. Children will then go back to class and be released at 3.15pm.
