XP East: Sami F

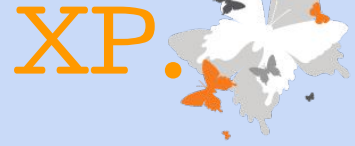


Working Hard, Getting Smart and Being Kind in maths all the time, and always.

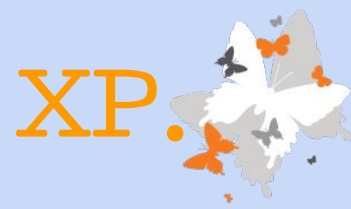


Dylan made incredible progress in Science due to incredible work ethic. Dylan worked really hard and had a positive impact on all students around him.

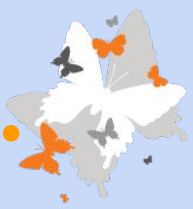


Kiera is the most improved student over time in X25 Science.

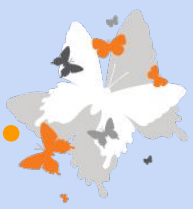


Declan worked extremely hard throughout his GCSE years at XP. Declan was always smiling and happy to be in lessons.

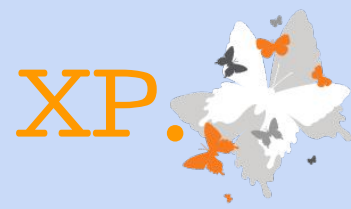

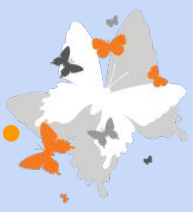


We would like to celebrate two students whose journey through the History GCSE landscape has been defined by unwavering commitment, resilience, and a relentless pursuit of excellence.

Congratulations to Ebony and Ruby for all your hard work, being an absolute pleasure to teach and beautiful people!

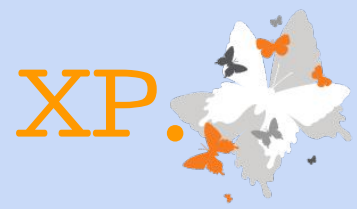

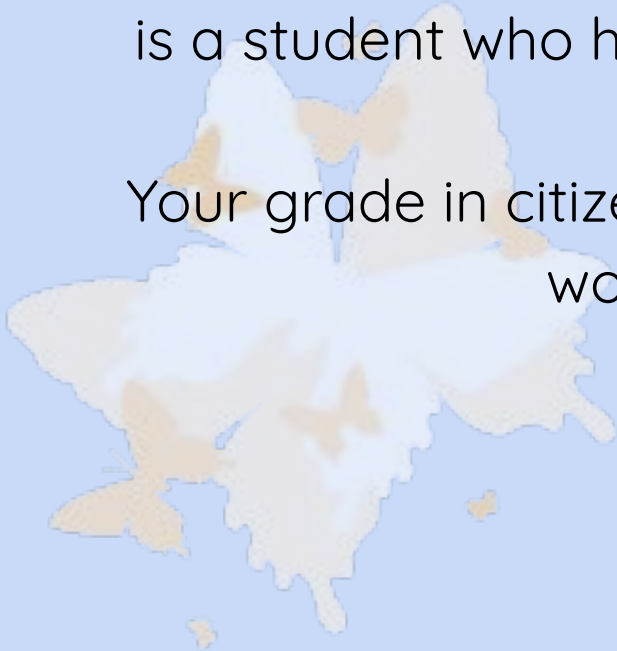

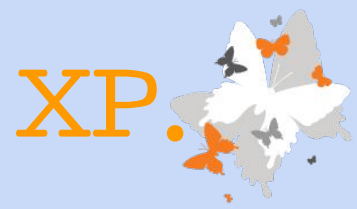
Mollie demonstrated consistent hard work for three years. Mollie is a student who has been focussed and driven at all times.

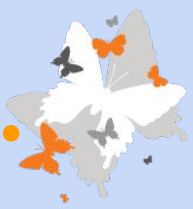

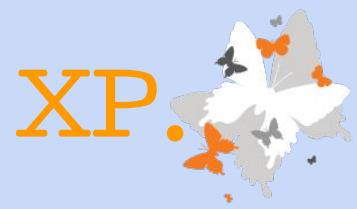

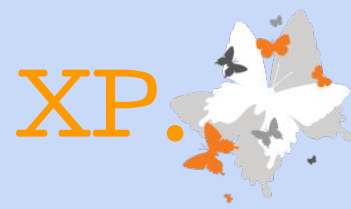
The hours Ava committed to her creative studies were inspirational.

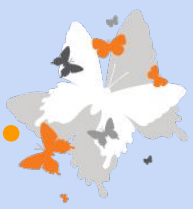


Grace produced phenomenal work for her Art GCSE. Her sketchbooks are absolutely filled with incredible quality illustrations.

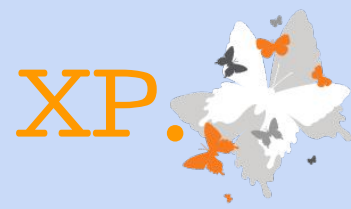

XP East: Charlie R

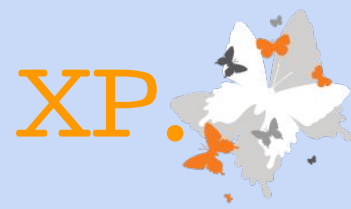


Charlie participated in the optional Madrid fieldwork visit last year, seizing the opportunity to practise his Spanish in purposeful interaction with native speakers.

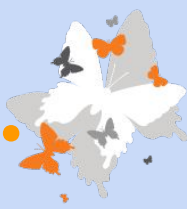
Beth achieved a Grade 7 at GCSE; falling short of a grade 8 by only 3 marks!

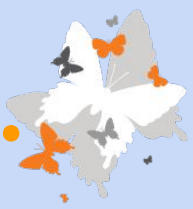


Jess has an exceptional memory, and worked extremely hard on other aspects of the course to achieve a Grade 5.

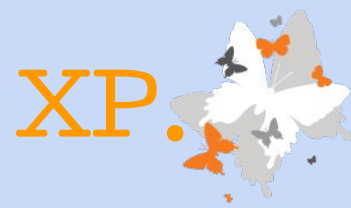

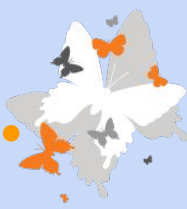
Callum was always focused with an outstanding attitude. Callum is an exemplary student who embodies all of XP's character traits - including working hard and getting smart.

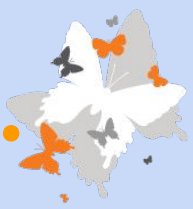


Declan is a fantastic student and has represented the school in sport on numerous occasions as sports person, referee and as a leader.

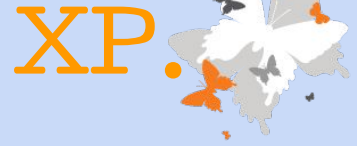

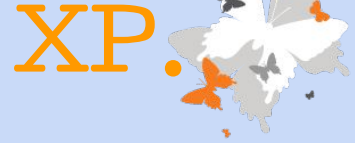


Ava has consistently worked hard and showed great determination to do the best she can throughout the 5 years at school.

Crew Turing - Callum A



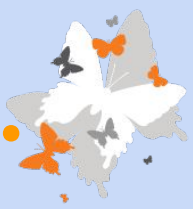
Awarded for Callum's constant hard work, checking in with others, putting in hours and hours of revision, and being the kindest soul to exist!!!

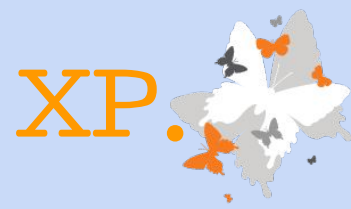


Jacob showed great determination and perseverance throughout his time here at XP East, especially in Year 11.

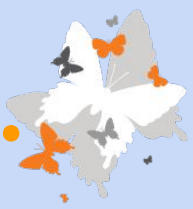

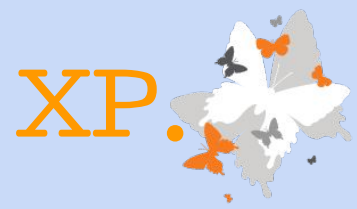

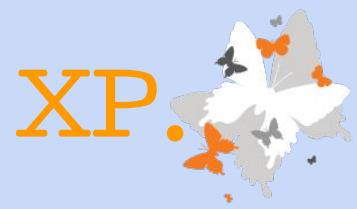
Ever since day one of Nada's XP journey she has constantly worked hard- she would go out of her way to help anyone.

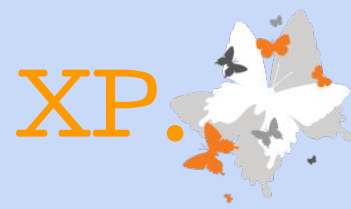


Throughout Beth's XP journey she produced the most beautiful work.

Grace displays all the character traits at XP. She produced some beautiful work in all of her sessions.

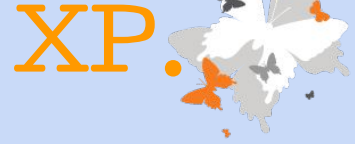
