

ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
SAINTS MARY and JOHN, SNOW HILL, WOLVERHAMPTON

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north-east at the junction of Railway Drive with the Railway Line at Wolverhampton Station:

1. South-east along the RAILWAY LINE to Cable Street;
2. West along CABLE STREET to Major Street (both sides);
3. South along MAJOR STREET and KENT ROAD to Bradley Road (neither side);
4. West and then south along BRADLEY ROAD to Pond Lane (neither side);
5. West along POND LANE and its continuation SILVER BIRCH ROAD to Birmingham Road/Thompson Avenue (neither side);
6. North for a short distance along BIRMINGHAM ROAD/THOMPSON AVENUE to Napier Road;
7. West along NAPIER ROAD to Dudley Road (both sides);
8. South for a short distance along DUDLEY ROAD to Ranelagh Road;
9. West along RANELAGH ROAD and its continuation HAGGAR STREET to Park Street South (neither side);
10. North for a short distance along PARK STREET SOUTH to Cross Street;
11. West along CROSS STREET to Upper Villiers Street (both sides);
12. South along UPPER VILLIERS STREET to Goldthorn Hill Road (both sides);
13. West along GOLDTHORN HILL ROAD to Rookery Lane (both sides);
14. North-west along ROOKERY LANE and its continuation STUBBS ROAD to Jeffcock Road (both sides);
15. North-west along JEFFCOCK ROAD to Bradmore Road (neither side);
16. North for a short distance along BRADMORE ROAD to Finchfield Road;
17. West for a short distance along FINCHFIELD ROAD to Richmond Road;
18. North-west along RICHMOND ROAD to Compton Road;
19. East along COMPTON ROAD and its continuation CHAPEL ASH to Darlington Street (neither side);
20. Continuing east along DARLINGTON STREET, through QUEENS SQUARE, along LICHFIELD STREET, through VICTORIA SQUARE, and finally along RAILWAY DRIVE to the Railway Line at Wolverhampton Station (neither side of any of these roads).
