

ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
SAINTS PETER and PAUL, WOLVERHAMPTON

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north-west at the junction of the Birmingham Canal with the Worcester Canal to the north of Dunstall Park:

1. South-west along the STAFFORDSHIRE & WORCESTERSHIRE CANAL across Tettenhall Road to Compton Road West;
2. East along COMPTON ROAD WEST to Compton Road;
3. Continuing east along COMPTON ROAD, CHAPEL ASH and DARLINGTON STREET, through QUEENS SQUARE, along LICHFIELD STREET, through VICTORIA SQUARE, and along RAILWAY DRIVE to the Railway Line at Wolverhampton Station (both sides of all these Roads and Squares to be included within the Parish);
4. North along the RAILWAY LINE to Stafford Road;
5. North along STAFFORD ROAD to the Birmingham Canal (both sides);
6. North-west along the BIRMINGHAM CANAL to its junction with the Staffordshire and Worcestershire Canal to the north of Dunstall Park.
