

ARCHDIOCESE OF BIRMINGHAM
PARISH BOUNDARIES
SAINT THERESA OF THE INFANT JESUS, PARKFIELD WOLVERHAMPTON

Interpretation of Boundaries:

1. A house or institution belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road into which opens its principal entrance.
2. A cul-de-sac, crescent, etc., having official opening(s) only onto one road belongs to the parish holding the road or side of the road having such official opening(s), unless the contrary be expressly stated.
3. The boundary always follows the middle of roads, lanes, footpaths, rivers, etc., unless stated otherwise.

Starting in the north at the junction of the Birmingham Road with Napier Road:

1. West along NAPIER ROAD to Dudley Road (neither side);
2. South for a short distance along DUDLEY ROAD to Ranelagh Road;
3. West along RANELAGH ROAD and its continuation HAGGAR STREET to Park Street South (both sides);
4. North for a short distance along PARK STREET SOUTH to Cross Street;
5. West along CROSS STREET to Upper Villers Street (neither side);
6. South along UPPER VILLERS STREET to Goldthorn Hill Road (neither side);
7. West along GOLDTHORN HILL ROAD to Coton Road (neither side);
8. South along COTON ROAD and continuing forward along the FOOTPATH to its end on Wakeley Hill (both sides);
9. South for a short distance along WAKELEY HILL to the Pylon Line (neither side);
10. East along the PYLON LINE, crossing the Wolverhampton Road near Greenleighs, and continuing to the Footpath along Beacon Hill, west of Farrington Road;
11. South along the FOOTPATH (middle of the Path) and its continuation BEACON LANE (neither side) to Monument Lane;
12. North-east along MONUMENT LANE to Beacon Street (neither side);
13. East along BEACON STREET to Dovedale Road (neither side);
14. Continuing north-east along WOODCROSS STREET and its continuation WOODCROSS LANE to Rookery Road (both sides);
15. South along ROOKERY ROAD to Birmingham New Road (both sides);
16. East across Birmingham New Road along ANCHOR LANE to the Railway Line (both sides);
17. North along the RAILWAY LINE to Cable street;
18. West along CABLE STREET to Major Street (neither side);
19. South along MAJOR STREET and KENT ROAD to Bradley Road (both sides);
20. West and then south along BRADLEY ROAD to Pond Lane (both sides);
21. West along POND LANE and its continuation SILVER BIRCH DRIVE to Birmingham Road /Thompson Avenue (both sides);
22. North along BIRMINGHAM ROAD/THOMPSON AVENUE for a short distance to its junction with Napier Road.
