



2020/2021 Key Stage 4 Results Analysis

At the end of the academic cycle 2020/2021, The Beacon Centre had a total of 12 Yr11 students on roll, of which two regularly accessed the Centre itself, 2 were school refusers and 8 accessed the Pathways Programme. Of these 12 young people, 9 (75%) can be considered Disadvantaged.

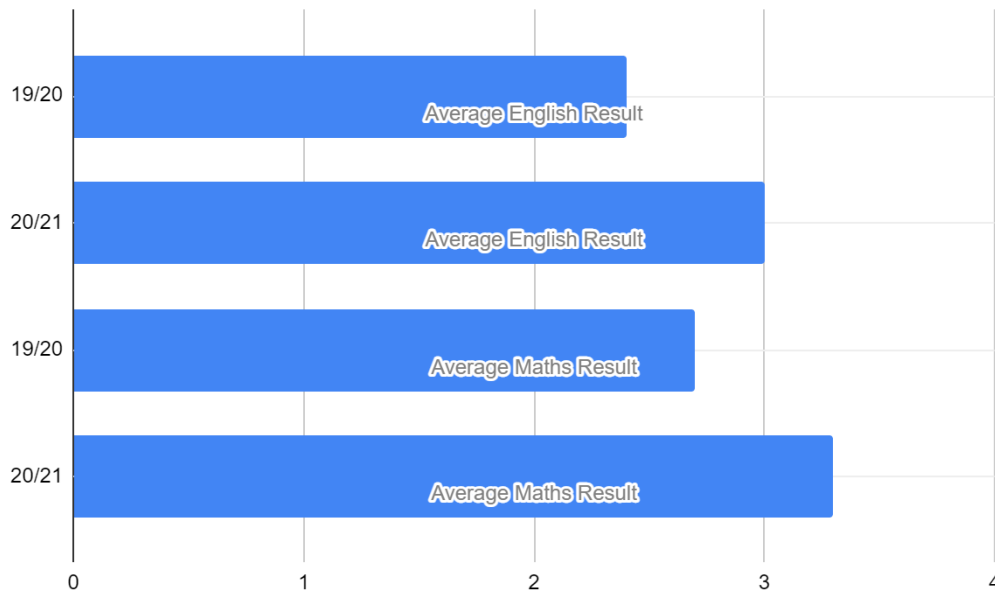
100% of students who accessed the Beacon Centre achieved a passing grade in GCSE English, Maths and Science, this is an increase of 8% on the previous academic cycle. Of those students who did not access the Beacon Centre but were not part of the Pathways Programme, 33% achieved passing grades in English and Maths with the average grade of 3.

When combined with all students in Year 11 the average grades for Maths and English look as follows:
